It's only a **BIN** fire!

Follow these simple steps to manage your waste:

- Keep bins in a locked compound
- Chain your bin to a post away from buildings
- Chain your bins together
- Make sure the lid is closed
- Store bins away from buildings and don't let rubbish accumulate
- DO NOT** put bins under windows
- DO NOT** put bins under guttering, fascias or soffits
- DO NOT** put bins under loading bays or gantries

Don't let your business suffer
