### **SDRR Engagement 2022 – Feedback**

Many thanks to everyone that provide suggestions on local risks to inform our review. The risks you identified included:

- Sites of Special Scientific Interest/Environmental Risk/Climate Change.
- Licensed/Unlicensed gatherings.
- Anti Social Behaviour/Deliberate fires/Wildfires.
- Pandemic & War in Ukraine.
- Population profile areas of greatest need.
- New housing – rented properties/social housing.
- Flooding/Water risk.
- Traffic/different modes of transport - electric vehicles.
- Hoarding.

These have been cross referenced and fed into the internal risk profiling exercise that DFRS has been undertaking. Your feedback confirmed that through our planning processes we had identified all the risks, nothing new came to light, and this is of great re-assurance to us. We will be using this information to ensure the Service is mitigating the risks for our next planning period - which is over the next 3 years.

Another of our aims of this engagement was to increase knowledge and understanding about the type of risks we deal with and 90% (34 people) said that getting involved had increased their awareness of risks DFRS covers. This is something we hope to build on in future.

We will be consulting on the resulting community risk management plan, which we call 'Our Plan' in winter 2022. Look out on our website and social media channels for your chance to get involved.
