Road Closed Signs

Derbyshire Fire & Rescue Service would like to remind people of the danger of ignoring road closed signs.

No matter what car you drive just 60cm of flood water will float your car.

Just 30cm of flowing water could be enough to move your car.

Just 15cm of fast-flowing water can knock you off your feet.

Drive Safely

With lots of surface water on the roads please slow down and leave plenty of space between you and the car in front.
