

Health Information

You will be required to complete a health declaration form prior to undertaking any assessments, and if successful at the assessments you will be invited to a medical / health appointment with the Occupational Health Unit. You should declare any health problems from the outset.

For the Reservist roles ONLY, if any of the following apply you may not be considered suitable for this role and therefore you should decide whether you wish to reserve a place on an assessment day.

- If you have a history of asthma or other breathing / respiratory conditions. If you have had childhood conditions prior to the age of 16 years you can reserve a place on an assessment day and further discussions will take place at the medical appointment if successful.
- If you have a colour vision deficiency (i.e. colour blindness).
- If you have ever had laser eye surgery? (i.e. post refractive surgery / LASIK or LASEK procedures).
- If you wear a hearing aid that not intrinsically safe. You can check with your hearing aid provider if you are unsure.
- If you wear glasses. The vision standards for the Reservist role is 6/9 with both eyes for distance and N12 with both eyes for near vision. You can check with your Optician if you are unsure.
- If you wear hard / rigid contact lenses. If you have soft type contact lenses you can reserve a place on an assessment day and further discussions will take place at the medical appointment if successful. You can check with your Optician if you are unsure.
- If you have been dismissed from any employment on the grounds of ill health.
